Mr. Huerta serves on the San Diego County Superior Court Mediation Panel and the Duke University Private Adjudication Center Mediation Panel (DUPAC). He is a mediator and arbitrator for the American Arbitration Association, and is a mediator and an arbitration chairperson for the National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc., and the New York Stock Exchange. Mr. Huerta has mediated approximately twenty cases around the country in a nationwide sexual discrimination and harassment class action administered through DUPAC. He mediates employment and EEO disputes for the United States Forest Service, Navy, Postal Service, and Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. He graduated from the University of Michigan Law School and was admitted to the California Bar in 1983.
